

The following Resolutions were passed by the Board of Directors and the Student Assembly of Gamma Nu Eta at our National Conference on March 31, 2012.

Amend Chapter VIII: CHAPTERS of the Gamma Nu Eta Constitution by adding a new Section 1.2 to read:

Section 1.2: An alumni chapter of the Society may be established in a college or university in the United States with a collegiate chapter in good standing as defined in Article VIII. The alumni chapter shall meet uniform criteria determined by the Board of Directors.

Amend ARTICLE IV: OFFICERS of the Gamma Nu Eta Constitution to read:

Section 3: The Board of Directors shall include the following national officer positions: Chair, Chair-elect, First Vice Chair, Second Vice Chair, Secretary, and Student National President. To be eligible for nomination to national officer positions except that of Student National President or Student Board Member, a candidate shall have previous service as a member director, committee chair, committee member, chapter adviser, alumni chapter officer or collegiate chapter officer and shall have been an active member of Gamma Nu Eta for a minimum of twelve months prior to nomination.

Section 4: There shall be three elected collegiate Student Board Members; the Student National President and two additional Student Board Members. The terms for these Student National Board members shall be one year.

Section 9. There shall be National Student Officers nominated by the collegiate chapters and elected by the student members. There shall be a Student National President, a Student National Vice President, and a Student National Secretary. The terms for these National Student Officers shall be one year. If the Student National VP and the Student National Secretary are not otherwise members of the board of directors, they shall be non-voting members of the board of directors.

At a point in the future to be determined by the Board of Directors, national dues will be imposed.

The colors of Gamma Nu Eta Honor Society shall be royal blue and silver.

The Mission of Gamma Nu Eta shall be "To recognize and promote leadership and excellence in the study of Information Technology; to offer knowledge and services to our members' schools and surrounding communities; and to play an active role in the application and evolution of Information Technology within society."
